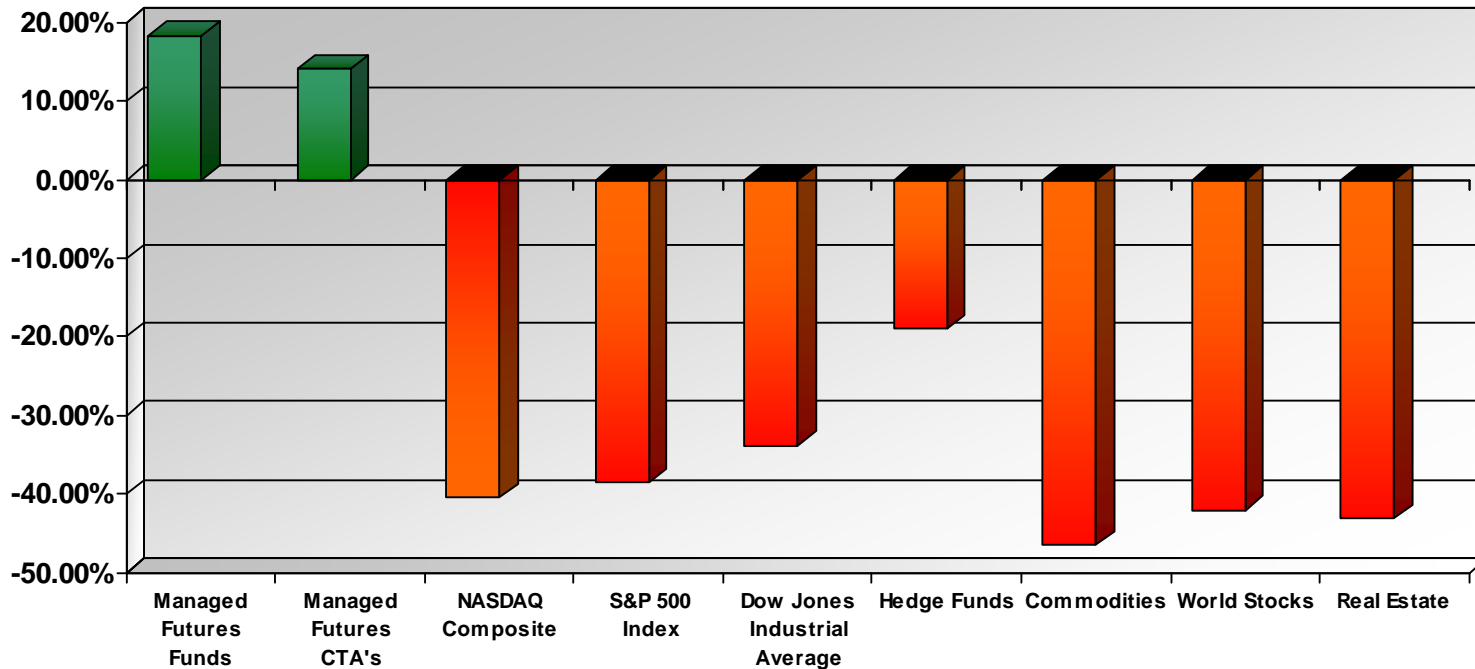


## 2008 Performance of Various Popular Indices

### 2008 Performance Data Sources and Definitions:

1. Credit Suisse/Tremont Managed Futures Index is an index comprised of 29 of the worlds largest audited managed futures funds.
2. The Barclay CTA Index is a leading industry benchmark representing the performance of individual commodity trading advisors. Be advised that Barclay's performance results are based on data received by CTAs who participate in contributing the information.
3. NASDAQ Composite Index is comprised of more than 4,000 domestic and international securities listed on the NASDAQ.
4. S&P 500 Index is a basket of 500 large cap stocks that are considered to be widely held and whose performance is thought to be representative of the stock market as a whole.
5. Dow Jones Industrial Average Index is comprised of 30 of the largest and most widely held public companies in the United States.
6. Credit Suisse/Tremont Hedge Fund Index is the largest asset weighted hedge fund index encompassing 496 hedge funds.
7. Goldman Sachs Commodity Index is a composite index of commodity sector returns representing an unleveraged, long-only investment in commodity futures that is broadly diversified across the spectrum of commodities.
8. The MSCI World Index measures the equity market performance of 23 major developed market country indices.
9. Dow Jones Wilshire Real Estate Securities Index is a broad measure of the performance of publicly traded real estate securities.
